PAYMENT POLICY: Monthly Tuition payments, by cash or check, are due at the beginning of each month. There will be no refunds or transfers. ENTIRE payment is expected each month, as this is one installment of a semester agreement. In case of absence the lesson may be made up in an alternate class. An overall 10% discount is available for more than one family member enrolled in the school. A 10% late fee will be assessed for payments received after the 15th of the month.

REQUIRED DRESS

Girls:

Beginners – short-sleeved light blue leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers.

Elementary and Intermediate – black tank leotard, black chiffon wrap skirt, pink tights, pink ballet slippers.

Advanced – black or dark leotard, pink tights, pink slippers, pointe shoes.

Boys and Men:

All classes – Black tank leotard or white tee shirt, black tights, white socks, white slippers.

All hair must be worn up – off the face and neck.

The dress code will be strictly enforced. Students will not be allowed to take class unless they are dressed properly and their hair is up. Dance is a disciplined art, and self-discipline and respect must be taught with the technique.



PERFORMANCE POLICY

Dance Directions Studio is the home of écarté dance theatre, a contemporary ballet and modern dance company.

Because écarté's philosophy embraces the unique gifts of each dancer, all students in the school are invited to participate in écarté's two major performances as novices or apprentices. Senior company members must audition with the artistic director.

Auditions are open to all dancers in the area, ages 15 and over, who are currently enrolled in a minimum of two ballet classes per week. écarté performance dates for the 2016-2017 season are January 14 and June 10.
